# Overall Personal Protective Equipment Strategies Being Implemented

- Expected use of masks and face shields by staff.
- Expected use of masks or face shields by students.
- Sneeze guards -- Main office space in the school.
- Mobile hand sanitizer stations in each Class.
- Hand washing stations/sanitizing stations in each classroom.
- Intentional physical distancing measures.
  - Take measures to reduce class size and maximize space -- remove furniture, master schedule changes
- Touchless thermometers in the school.
- Disinfectant wipes available in each classroom.
- Disinfectant spray bottle in every classroom.
